The grapes for this wine were grown in the Ancient Lakes AVA just three and a half our drive south of the winery. The picturesque vineyard overlooks the majestic Columbia Gorge. Set high above the Columbia River, the AVA is known for its cooler sites and white grapes dominate the region. This is rare in Washington and something we sought when looking to source grapes to make some white wine.

This 100% Marsanne wine features big concentrated aromas and flavours, medium bodied mouthfeel with a long finish. It is a very versatile wine and will pair beautifully with our west coast seafood or simply poured with sunshine and friends.
